Key Milestones

Since its opening in January 2024, ES550 has become a thriving hub of innovation and collaboration. Key achievements include:

- Welcomed a growing number of tech startups and businesses to our space.
- → Maintained an average of 35% booking capacity each month for amenities at the new campus.
- + Hosted over 50 dynamic programs, ranging from workshops to community events.
- Collaborated with over 30 esteemed organizations, including the City of Newark, Invest Newark, the S.B.A. (National Chapter), Audible, and LISC NJ.

Enhanced Resources

ES550 was designed to offer members cuttingedge tools and an inspiring environment to thrive. Highlights include:

Advanced Tech Capabilities: Members benefit from Newark's fiber optics for ultra-fast internet and a convenient 15-minute commute to New York City. AlphaRoc, one of our members, leverages these advantages, providing their NYC-based team with seamless connectivity and improved access to meetings.

Expanded Office Spaces: Our large-scale offices accommodate teams of up to 25 members, with the flexibility to expand to 50 as businesses grow. These spaces are perfect for hosting seminars, press experiences, and more.

Member Spotlight: Fitnescity

Laila Zemrani, founder of Fitnescity, launched her health and wellness platform at EqualSpace. Fitnescity connects individuals to health tests and data analytics to improve fitness and prevent lifestyle-related diseases.

Starting with two private suites, Laila quickly expanded into one of our larger HQ spaces, growing her team within months.

The resources at ES550, coupled with its proximity to NYC, have been pivotal to Fitnescity's success and ability to scale.

The Blueprint Experience aimed to break down barriers to funding and provide actionable strategies for business owners to diversify their teams and secure investment for growth.


Impact and Reach

With the additional floors coming online in Fall 2025, ES550 will provide scalable spaces and innovative resources for a growing community of entrepreneurs and creators.

Here's what to expect:

2nd Floor:

Event Space: A versatile venue accommodating 250+ people with a dedicated A/V room.

Breakout Rooms: Two rooms, each with a capacity of 100 people.

Boardroom: 25-person capacity for focused meetings.

Podcast Rooms: Two specialized spaces, including one with visual support.

Multimedia Studio: A large-scale studio with private equipment cages.

Warming Kitchen: Perfect for event catering needs.

Lobby: A stylish 150+ person lobby with a 360-degree bar.


Green Rooms: Three dedicated spaces, one equipped with facilities for hair and makeup.

Strengthening our role as a hub for **collaboration** and innovation, ensuring every member has access to resources that fuel their growth.


Introducing **targeted campaigns** to showcase the impact of ShareSpace on individual success stories, building our reputation as a leader in co-working spaces.
